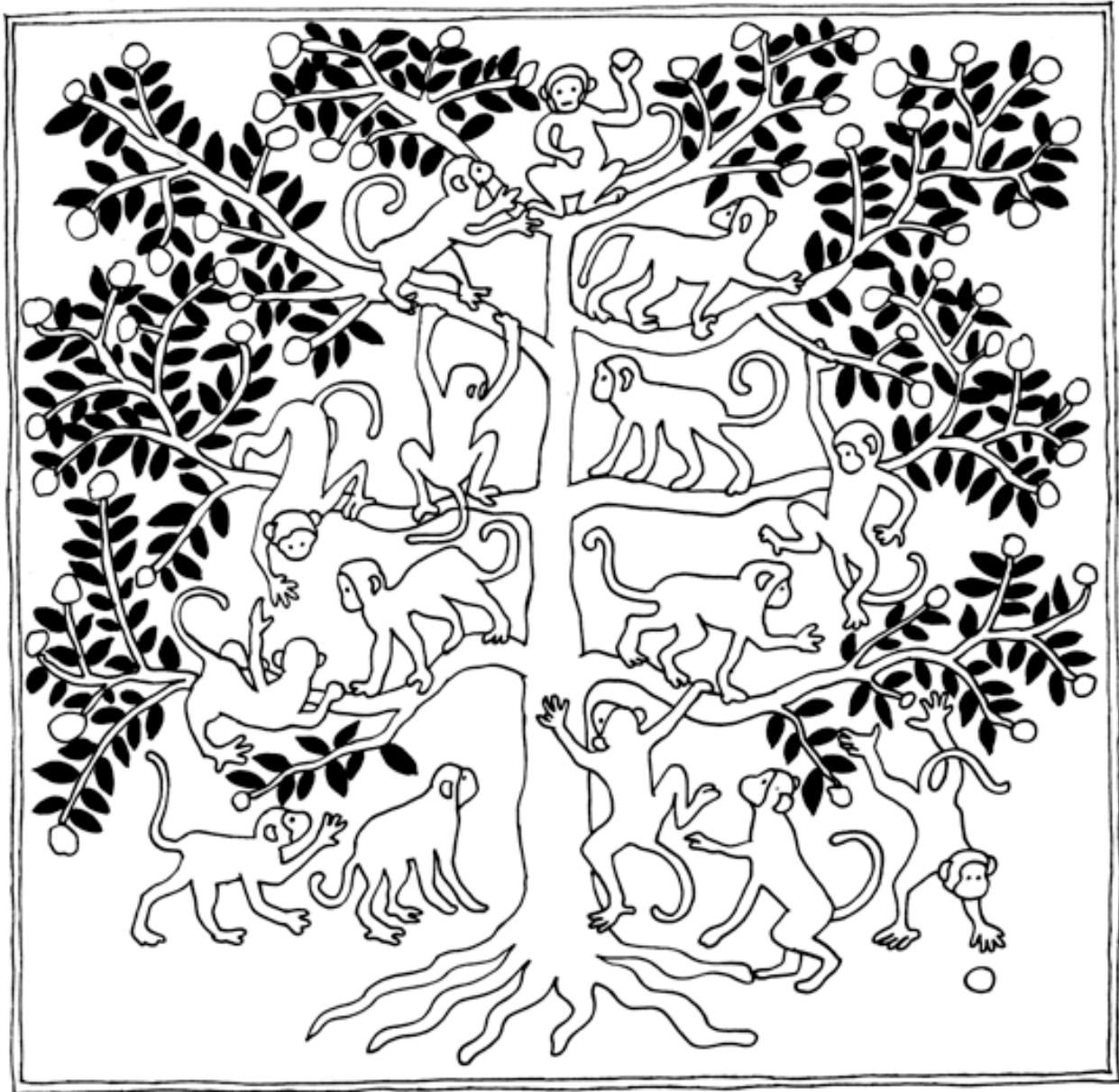

Discussion Questions and Activities (3 levels)

Pre-K

1. How many monkeys are in the tree?
2. What are they doing?
3. Where do monkeys live?
4. Tell a story together. "Once there was a monkey named Lee. He was very hungry, so he decided to look for some food..."
5. Draw or paint your own pictures of monkeys.
6. Take a trip to the zoo.
7. Read books about monkeys.
8. Eat a banana like a monkey.
9. Go to the park and climb like a monkey.

Grades 1-3

1. Why are the monkeys in the tree?
2. Can they talk? What are they saying?
3. What will they do next?
4. Have you seen real monkeys? Where?
5. Tell a story together.
6. Draw or paint pictures of monkeys.
7. Draw or paint a house for these monkeys.
8. Read books about monkeys.
9. Make cloth or paper puppets.
10. Take a trip to the zoo.
11. Write a story about a monkey.
12. Ask someone from Asia or Africa about monkeys.

Grades 4-6

1. What is a good title for this picture?
2. Would monkeys make good pets?
3. What problems might happen if wild monkeys lived near you?
4. Can you think of solutions for those problems?
5. Tell a story together.
6. Draw or paint pictures of monkeys.
7. Write a story about your pictures.
8. Observe different kinds of monkeys at a zoo.
9. Compare and contrast different species.
10. Research a species of monkey.
11. Find places where monkeys live on a world map.
12. Find out if any monkeys are endangered.
13. Interview someone from Asia about monkeys.
